Grants Approved: Gun Violence

The following grants were approved at the April 16, 2009 meeting of the Board of Directors.

American College of Preventive Medicine

Washington, DC \$203,193

To support education and advocacy around the continuation and expansion of the National Violent Death Reporting System. (1 yr.)

International Association of Chiefs of Police

Alexandria, VA \$250,000

To continue implementation efforts around the recommendations contained in the report of the Great Lakes States Summit on Gun Violence. (1 yr.)

Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene and Public Health

Baltimore, MD \$179,971

For support of research on policies that can more effectively restrict firearm ownership to law-abiding persons. (2 yrs.)

Legal Community Against Violence

San Francisco, CA \$340,000

For core support to Legal Community Against Violence (LCAV) to provide legal and technical assistance in support of state and local gun violence prevention policy reform efforts. (20 mos.)

University of California, Davis

Sacramento, CA \$175,000

For core support of the Violence Prevention Research Program's work on research and policy development focused on firearm violence and its prevention. (2 yrs.)
